Biblical passages often speak of freedom from sin and slavery through faith in God, which can be seen as comparable in certain respects to the political independence celebrated on Independence Day. Additionally, the Bible emphasizes the importance of gratitude for blessings, which can be applied to the freedoms enjoyed in a nation. The Bible frequently speaks of spiritual freedom, particularly freedom from sin and the bondage of the law through faith in Jesus Christ:

- John 8:36: "So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed," (NIV)
- Galatians 5:1: "It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery," (NIV)

The Bible highlights freedom as a gift that enables individuals to serve God and live according to His will.

Psalm 118:5: "Out of my distress I called on the Lord; the Lord answered me and set me free," (ESV)
